LGBTQ Iowans and Allies to Raise Their Voices at LGBTQ Day on the Hill

[Des Moines]—One Iowa Action, the affiliated advocacy arm of statewide LGBTQ organization One Iowa will host **LGBTQ Day on the Hill on Tuesday, January 30** to provide LGBTQ Iowans and allies with a concentrated day of action to get involved in Iowa's political process.

"Our state has a strong legacy of equality, but some Iowans want to strip that legacy away from LGBTQ people," **One Iowa Action Executive Director Daniel Hoffman-Zinnel** said.
